

MoFRW Club and District Presidents

January:

1. Make sure your treasurer has collected club members' dues and submitted them along with the transmittal form to the MoFRW Membership Chair.
2. Encourage your club/district to attend the Show-Me Action Conference held the end of January or early February. There are lots of speakers and workshops for everyone concluding with a Board of Directors meeting.

February:

1. Distribute information and encourage your club to attend Lincoln Days held in different places around the state each year. Usually it is held the end of February. The MoFRW hosts a luncheon open to everyone.
2. Start encouraging your members to attend Legislative Day held at the Capitol in Jefferson City in March. Wear your Red and join the MoFRW to hear from our legislators and special speakers. It is held in conjunction with Breckenridge Scholar Day.

March:

1. Encourage your club to attend Legislative Day and get registrations turned in by the deadline. It is usually held the second Tuesday of every March.
2. Make sure each club president and member is aware of your District's Spring/Fall meeting and encourage everyone to attend.

April:

1. The official Call for the MoFRW Convention will be mailed to Club Presidents this month. It is your responsibility to copy and distribute the Call to your members. Copies will also be available on the MoFRW website. Each club President and District President is on the Board of Directors and will need to submit your credentials included in the packet in order to be seated and vote at the Convention. Each club in good standing will also have 2 Delegates (and 2 Alternates) having voting privileges at the Convention. Convention is hosted by a different District each year. There are strict deadlines to submit Credential forms.
2. Prepare your club's MoFRW Club Achievement Award forms and have them submitted to the Achievement Award Chair by the deadline usually in early May. Awards are distributed at the MoFRW Convention in June.

May:

1. Make sure your credential forms have been submitted by the deadline.
2. Encourage your club to attend the Annual Convention in June.
3. Club and District Presidents will submit a report for your club/district to the MoFRW President on your activities over the past year.
4. Submit names/bios of club members who have passed away over the past year to the MoFRW Chaplain to be remembered at the MoFRW Convention Memorial Service held at Convention in June.
5. Turn in club Achievement Award forms to MoFRW Achievement Award chair.

June:

1. Attend the MoFRW Convention usually held the first or second weekend in June. Everyone is encouraged to attend.

August:

1. The MoFRW assists in the Republican tent at the Missouri State Fair. Be sure to stop by!

September:

1. Make sure each of your club/district members are aware of the District Fall meeting and encourage them to attend.

November:

1. The next year's membership transmittal forms are mailed to club treasurers. Begin collecting dues to submit to the MoFRW Membership Chair by the end of December.
2. Notices will be sent to clubs asking for nominations of young ladies that are juniors or seniors in high school to be chosen as Breckenridge Scholars to be honored the next March.

December:

1. The deadline to submit a young lady to be a Breckenridge Scholar is due by the 31st.
